Without what seems to be a little/minor role covered, it only means that someone else will have to do it, or juggle a number of jobs to ensure our kids can play football. To our coaches and training assistants, thanks for giving up your time to coach our kids, without your assistance our kids would not be able to develop their skills and play each week. Maybe next year as the U13 group move to U14 where football starts to become a little more serious, we may see Alex Weston finally take a training session in the rain, I am sure the kids would want to – only time will tell.

Congratulations to Jason Nguyen from our U16 group who finished equal 5th in the WRFL Best and Fairest in U16C, and to Atali Patrice for winning the U13 WRFL Best and Fairest after being bridesmaid for a couple of years. These are both outstanding achievements when you take into account the number of footballers that play in each grade each week.

Also a special mention to the 6 boys who ended up playing with North Footscray this season as we could not field our own U14 team. I am glad that it all worked out and North Footscray looked after you, you are still a part of our club and I am sure everything possible will be done so that we can cater for you next season.

Our U9 group saw the introduction of a new coach to our ranks, Brenny Lawson, and a new team manager in Kirstie Prentice. Brenny, being a big kid himself, fitted into the role well once he was able to work out how to control the kids. Timing was also good for Brenny with a couple of senior or ex senior players as parents/helpers. This can be a hard group to coach as it is a balance between fun and learning skills of our game, too much fun and kids don't learn as much as they should, not enough and training becomes like a classroom where it is easy to get distracted or lose interest. By all accounts I believe Brenny was able to get this right, and in the end I am not sure who had more fun Brenny or the kids.

Most of the U10 group this year had been coached by Colin Green when they were in U9's the year before, and again we saw steady improvement in the group throughout the season. There is no scoreboard, but we always knew when they had won, and there were more reported wins than losses so that should hold the kids in good stead as they progress to the competition age group in U11.

Our U12 group did not see the success they saw the year before when the U11's made the preliminary final, but after losing some players and picking up some new ones it took a while for the kids to get to know each other and come together as a team. They had a few wins and were competitive in most games, thanks to Brian Hocking (Scratcher) for taking this group on and passing on his knowledge. The scoreboard may not have shown the results we wanted, but it is not always about winning, it is how you play and what you learn. I believe this group came a long way from where they started and they will be better for it next year.

Our U13 group – Premiers, a great result for our club and especially all involved with this group, hopefully this removed the memories of a grand final that got away 2 years ago in the U11's. A huge congratulations to the coaching staff and helpers, reward for all your time and efforts. We have seen this two years in a row now, nothing better than seeing how the kids react when the siren goes, it makes what we do all worthwhile. We are not all about winning, but it sure tastes nice when it comes our way. Yes, our kids did excited, as you would have expected, but they showed a tremendous amount of respect to how the opposition must have been feeling as most of our kids had been on the losing end before. They should be congratulated for this. Like the U14's the year before, this group has now been etched into our clubs history and their photo will be on the club wall for the rest of time.

Our U16 group, like last year, probably frustrated the life out of Luke Woods at times, they showed plenty of potential but at times could not put that into a four quarter effort on game day. In saying that we had a few new players this year, a couple returned after a few years off and the start of the season they weren't under any pressure in U16D as they won games without really breaking into a sweat. We probably cost this group a premiership, but we had to move up a grade as it wasn't doing their development any good where they were. They were competitive at times, but as they found out it takes a four quarter effort to win a game. One of the better games they played was their last home game against Werribee, who turned up thinking they would have an easy win and our boys nearly grabbed the chocolates, but ended up falling just short.

We are not sure what the future holds for this group with WRFL going against our wishes and we believe that of the other clubs (although they have not spoken up as yet), in changing the age group to U17 will stop the natural progression of players to our U18 group which is now U19.

Tracey and I may be stepping down from our role, but we will be around to assist whoever takes over from us. I know we are in a good place by the quality of young men that complete our junior program each season (progress to what was U18). This is a testament to our coaches and the quality people we have around our club, as in the world we live in today with all the challenges that life throws up, winning isn't always everything, teaching life skills and developing young people is.

Finally, next season to make life easier on our new administrators, remember when something needs to be done, don't be afraid to put your hand up and step forward to offer your assistance, you will always get any help you need to get the role that you have taken on done. TREASURERS REPORT

Dear Members,

I present to you 2015 Financial Report for the Sunshine Football Club.

Financially this year has been a lot more difficult than in previous years and we need to make small changes to the way we operate to put the club back into a good financial position for the 2016 season and beyond.

As I had stated last year, we need to spend the time and effort concentrating on specific areas of fund raising and cost saving in order to get us back on track. The challenge, as always, is to make sure we spread ourselves across all areas of revenue and expenses in order to make sure we are meeting our budget requirements.

The environment we are playing in means the cost of putting teams on the field every year is increasing, both seniors and juniors. We are being forced to purchase more football equipment from the leagues suppliers and with the increasing league administration costs and player payment requirements we need to work on bringing in more profit year on year.

This year we had a few sponsors pull out during the season and Coterie/200 Club participation did not increase to the numbers we had anticipated. We also had a few functions that did not bring in the revenue we had budgeted for. Our bar profits are also not at the levels we would hope for, which is a sign of the times. As a club we need to attract new sponsors, increase our Coterie/200 Club participation and have functions that are good revenue spinners for the club. We need to continue to look at areas that help us cut costs and look at ways of attracting more people to the club to use our facilities that we continue to improve year on year.

I would like to take the opportunity to thank those that helped in managing all our different revenue lines, on behalf of the club, I am extremely grateful. Your contribution does not go unnoticed!

As always, we need to work on our operating model in order to maximise our revenue and decrease our expenses and along with the committee this is something we will strive to do again in 2016.

In closing, I would like to thank my fellow committee members and all our volunteers for their time and effort and those many members who contribute to the club financially in different ways. Your hard work and support goes a long way in the way we function.

I look forward to working with you once again in 2016.
