Our U13 side also showed improvement, they may not have made finals but they ended up being the best of the rest. Dear Members,

I present to you the 2016 Financial Report for the Sunshine Football Club.

Last year I stated how difficult the year had been financially and this year things have not got any better. I was hoping to be in a better position in 2016 by making small changes to the way we operate to put the club back into a good financial position. We have had some very difficult challenges across both areas of revenue and expenses which has made it difficult to meet our budgeted requirements.

Every year the cost of putting teams on the field in juniors and seniors is increasing. With supplier costs also increasing we need to manage our expenses even more intensely to ensure we are a viable club in the years to come.

This year we attracted a few more sponsors but we also had a few pull out which makes it difficult to move forward with momentum. In 2016, much like 2015, our participation in the Coterie/200 Club did not increase. These are two areas of revenue that we are looking at real closely in 2017. Our functions were well attended but the costs of running such functions is ever increasing so we need to work out what direction we want to move on in this space. Our profits over the bar continue to decline which is a real worry and a real sign of the times.

As stated in previous years as a club we need to attract new sponsors, increase our Coterie/200 Club participation and have functions that are good revenue spinners for the club. We need to continue to look at areas that help us cut costs and look at ways at attracting more people to the club to use our facilities that we continue to improve year on year.

A club like ours does not run on its own. As the Treasurer it is important that I get help across all revenue lines. I want to thank all those members that help manage those particular lines on behalf of the club, I am extremely grateful. Your contribution and help is something I could not do without!

As always, we need to continue to reinvent ourselves to maximise our revenue and decrease our expenses and along with the committee this is something we will strive to do again in 2017. In closing I would like to thank my fellow committee members and all our volunteers for their time and effort and those many members who contribute to the club financially in different ways. Your hard work and support goes a long way in how we function.

I look forward to working with you once again in 2017.


WESTERN REGION FOOTBALL LEAGUE REPRESENTATIVES – 2016
