OBITUARY

Phillip Michael Shine

25th May 1946 – 26th August 2017

Towards the end of the season the club lost a long time supporter in Phil Shine. Phil started playing for Sunshine YCW in 1962, after gaining a clearance from Braybrook in the Footscray District Football League. He was not gifted with speed or ability, but he was very consistent and extremely persistent, so much so that he was awarded the Reserves Best and Fairest award in 1971 and 1975. He was Captain Coach of the Reserves in 1969, 1972 and 1973 and he also coached the Under 18's to a Premiership in 1971. Phil served on the Committee as Secretary from 1972 to 1974 and remained on the Committee until 1978. He was awarded Life Membership in 1977. He played 227 games for the club.

Phil was a very likeable character and there are many stories that could be told about his time at Sunshine YCW. Probably the best was one Good Friday working bee at the ground when Phil was asked to go to the fish and chip shop to get the lunch. He returned with fish and chips and a pile of dim sims, which didn't go down too well with Fr Walsh who was astounded that somebody would buy dim sims for a Catholic working bee on Good Friday.
