Dear Members,

I present to you the 2018 Financial Report for the Sunshine Football Club.

While we did not have the success on the field we would have liked following 2017, this year has been quiet successful off the field when it comes to the club's financial position. But to be in this position takes an enormous amount of work and determination and sometimes that comes at a cost. It is something that we need to continue to be weary of. There are only so many times you can continue to go to the same well.

As every other year the cost of fielding all our teams continues to head in an upwards direction. It does seem we now have a good operating model and we know where we stand and can quickly jump on to issues before they become full blown catastrophizes. The area we need to continue to improve on is our professionalism. We can at times be very slow off the mark because too much is left to too few. We continue to need support from others, and not just for 1 or 2 years (as these are the learning years) but for many multiple years.

Our sponsorship continued to grow on the level we had made in 2017 and with the continued revamped our Supporter Group packages this continues to be a massive revenue stream for our club. Functions continue to be well attended and with a new social committee we really raised the bar on a number of events. But as always the costs of running such functions is ever increasing and we need to look at sponsorship opportunities when holding these events - whether it be having the events sponsored or holding events at venues that sponsor us. Our profits over the bar while don't look good on paper (even though they are nowhere near the levels we had over the last decade) are staying steady when we consider how we are now using the bars income stream.
