Coaches Comments

Main challenges for the year predominately focused around the initial set up of the team and understanding of the machinations of game day - particularly due to the lower numbers and late call in having an u8's. We basically required as many volunteer parents for the required roles as we had players. Obviously this had its difficulties early as everyone was learning on the go and not everyone wants to come and help out with a role every week - which is fair enough.

I would recommend in future that all players play in their respective age groups and only participate outside this on a weekly needs basis. I understand the anomalies of the situation we faced this year, (with no u8's scheduled and a lot of the boys already signed on the u10's). However it did lead to difficulties getting a team some weeks (we only had 7 players for 3 games) and undue responsibility placed on Brendan to roster his players while trying to meet the expectations of parents i.e. having too many players weekly when a number of them could have played u8's. Luckily he did a great job of this but it could be avoided if players stayed in their age groups.

All in all, I found it a really enjoyable experience - basically great efforts put in by the administration, namely Mark, who deserves great credit for the fantastic job he did throughout the campaign.

Heritage Jumper round 60th Anniversary

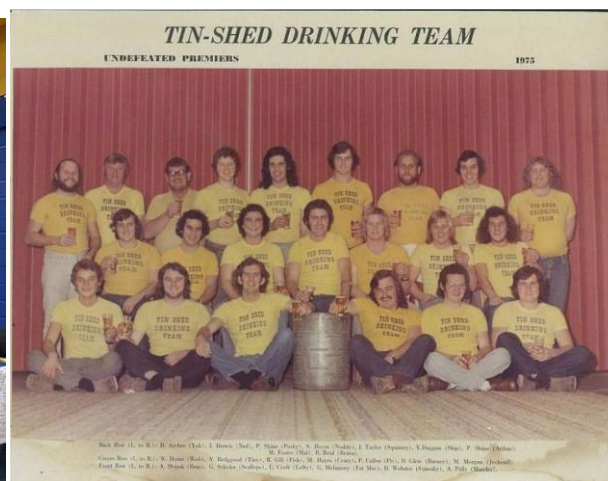
