PETER EVANS LIFE MEMBER 1971

Peter first came onto the committee as the Secretary/Treasurer in 1962 & remained until 1990.

Peter performed many functions at the club that included being the Team Manager of the senior team for many years. In addition to his commitments to Sunshine YCW Peter also served on the Executive of the YCW, responsible for running the entire YCW competition.

He was made a Life Member of the YCWNFA in 1975. In honour of his years of dedicated service to Sunshine YCW Football Club the committee room has been named after him. 


Trent Waring
