Season 2023 was a season of huge change, both off and on the field. Following successive years of struggle in Division 1 for the senior team, we were relegated to Division 2.

We hired a new Senior Coach, in Ben Chapman, and made a focus both on and off the field to reunite the football club.

Another great achievement for our club this year was the success of our netballers, winning a premiership with a fantastic a closely fought finals series – Again, a fantastic launching pad for what is to come.

Off the field, we had greater engagement with our sponsors and past players – as was evidenced by record levels of sponsorship and packed clubrooms after many home games.

The platform is now strong for 2024 – with great stability on and off the field to set the bar higher and aim for greater success.

We aim to have a stronger netball programme in 2024, with a focus on a women's football programme to commence planning.

PETER EVANS LIFE MEMBER 1971



Peter first came onto the committee as the Secretary/Treasurer in 1962 & remained until 1990.

Peter performed many functions at the club that included being the Team Manager of the senior team for many years. In addition to his commitments to Sunshine YCW Peter also served on the Executive of the YCW, responsible for running the entire YCW competition.

She was best known for fund raising, Marj's ability to sell raffle tickets was phenomenal & her efforts over 40 years contributed many thousands of dollars to the club.

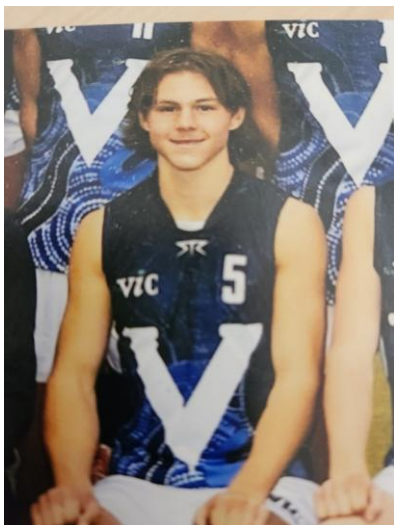
Jude Elcheikh
